On behalf of our Mathematics Department, Welcome to Webber Academy!

For students new to Webber Academy, it is our practice to administer a mathematics diagnostic examination within two weeks of the start of the school year. Your achievement on this examination does not affect your grade. Rather, it indicates which topics (if any) need additional review for a successful first year in our mathematics programme.

Each new student writes the final examination from the previous grade. A student joining us for grade 12 would write the grade 11 final examination. You are expected to schedule a suitable two-hour period with your math teacher within the first two weeks of the school year. The results of your exam will promptly be shared with you and your parents.

In preparation for your exam, we recommend two resources. First, we suggest purchasing SNAP: Math 11. It is available at major bookstores and can be purchased online. Second, we suggest borrowing a MATHPOWER11 textbook from our main office.


With respect to SNAP: Math 11, you are expected to be familiar with all concepts and work requirements.
