This will be Ben Lukenchuk's fourth year at the Webber Academy Debate Boot Camp. Ben has been involved in the speech and debate community for over 10 years. He holds an honour's (Victoria) and master's (McMaster) degree in Economics. Ben has extensive debate experience including being a member of Team Alberta at national competitions for both speech and debate and serving as the captain and coach of the Gustavson School of Business Debate Team at the University of Victoria. In 2013, he was the recipient of the Mike Dorval Award for his contributions to the speech community in Alberta. Most recently, Ben interned at the European Commission in the Directorate General of Education, Youth, Sport and Culture.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

The cost for the camp is \$380. It runs for four days, July 2 - July 5, 2019 from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

The fee covers daily workshops, a morning snack, lunch, and a final day BBQ. Dress comfortably and bring some appropriate gear for activities outside.

If you are from out of town you will need to arrange accommodation for the duration of the camp.
