Bursary Program Information

The Webber Academy Bursary Fund provides assistance to families with children that are not able to financially meet the tuition fees. The Bursary Fund is supported through corporate and community donations and from revenues generated by Webber Academy.

The amount of the bursary is based on the family's net income from the previous year, taking into account the number of dependents in the family and whether there has been a substantial change in the ability of the family to earn an income. Unique circumstances or special situations are also taken into consideration.

To be eligible for a bursary, please submit the following information by April 22, 2022:

1. A Bursary Application form.
2. A copy of the Family's Income Tax Returns for 2021.
3. A copy of the Notice of Assessments for 2021.
4. A formal letter outlining any additional information, including any unusual circumstances, which would help us assess your financial need.
5. You may be required to submit an affidavit.

Additional requirements:

- Tuition fees from the 2021-2022 school year must be paid in full.
- \$3,000.00 tuition deposit relating to the 2022-2023 school year, due February 1, 2022.
- \$6,000.00 tuition deposit relating to the 2023-2023 school year, due April 1, 2022.

Final decisions are determined by the Bursary Committee of Webber Academy Board of Directors.
